Decision Record

- 1. The meeting was convened at 17:00 hours (5:00 PM).
- It was decided to hold the spring shareholders' meeting on Wednesday the 15th of June at 7 PM (19:00) so that a more complete picture of our membership status could be made available. There will be 2 principal agenda items:
 - The 2015 financial report; and
 - A discussion on the issue of slow play. What initiatives do the members wish the Board to take?
- 3. Under the supervision of our Manager, Dan Kolar, the reconstruction of the dining room into a lounge bar and the refurbishment/repainting of the current lounge area should be complete by the end of April. The overall concept is to move the relaxation area to the river/golf course end of the clubhouse so that more people will be able to enjoy the view.

- 4. Thanks to the initiative of our President, John Stanton, a large number of tables and chairs in excellent condition were procured from an establishment in Brockville that went out of business.
- 5. The manager was asked to obtain an estimate for the replacement of the window blinds throughout the main floor because they have yellowed with age (and therefore do not fit the new colour decor) and are actually "tacky" from the days when smoking was permitted indoors.
- 6. The total cost of the reconstruction/refurbishment work is currently estimated to be \$35,000. The new blinds will add upward pressure to this approximate cost. The new draft beer lines and dispenser heads are being paid for by Molson's in return for the club using their products on tap.
- The profit from our 2015 operations was determined to be \$132,089. This includes a one-time "Gain on Disposal of Capital Assets" of \$46,495, reflecting the trade-in value of the old carts and the sale of the old rough mower.
- The Board intends to gradually increase the operating expenditure (OPEX) contingency fund from its current level of \$56,000 to \$100,000. Fulfilling this intention will depend largely upon profits from green fees, cart rentals, and bar sales.
- 9. The greenskeeper currently estimates a 2016 opening date between 21 and 27 April.
- 10. The retaining wall on the river side of the clubhouse has collapsed. After a briefing by the Greenskeeper and a short on-site inspection, it was decided not to replace this wall. Some grading of the associated flower bed and adding some

quarry boulders will be done instead. This is a much less expensive alternative and, if a future-year project proceeds, could dove-tail with the idea to build a wooden deck on that side of the clubhouse that will wrap around towards a refurbished patio.

- 11. There have been 21 new members join since the start of our fall special late last summer. The overall 2016 membership count remains uncertain at this point.
- 12. The Buz on-line reservation system for green fee players should be ready for a demonstration by the end of April. A minimum of 2 players will be required to use it and the green fee players will not see the names of members, only the available tee time slots. Single green fee players will have to call the Pro Shop to obtain a suitable tee time. The Buz system currently used by the members will be unaffected.
- 13. Responding to a request from a member, the Board considered whether to allow "limited" members (weekday, afternoon play only) to play weekend tournaments if they pay green fees. It was decided not to permit this. Fully privileged members only will be allowed to play in competitive events.
- 14. Two (2) pace-of-play clocks will be installed at the mid-way point of each nine to help address a growing concern that our club has a reputation for slow play. Our thanks to Earle Maguire for suggesting this. Amending our score cards to indicate suggested time milestones will be investigated, but there may not be sufficient space.
- 15. The sign near the clubhouse will also be modified to show that a round time of four (4) hours is expected. Wireless video cameras will be considered, with a view to giving the Pro Shop

a capability to detect gaps between groups and respond accordingly.

- 16. Additional ideas for how to deal with the slow play issue will be welcomed at our 15 June shareholders' meeting.
- 17. It was decided not to move the Sunshine Boys and some intersectional play to later in the morning. The former typically takes up only an hour or two of morning play time one day per week and most intersectional events are not scheduled for the early morning.
- 18. A wooden tree carving is being considered for the practice putting green area. If this project proceeds, members will be asked to donate \$100 each to fulfill the estimated cost of \$2000.
- 19. One (1) copy of our club history book will be printed and put on display in the clubhouse, with a view to encouraging firm orders from interested members. Our thanks to Joe McLean for his diligent research, writing, and assembly of this work.
- 20. Through the auspices of our President, the Canadian Oldtimers' Hockey Association will hold their annual tournament at the Mississippi (3 June 2016; 1 PM shotgun start for approximately 120 players).
- 21. The manager was tasked with setting up a "chit" system whereby members <u>may</u> charge green fees, carts, and beverages and receive a monthly statement by mail (net 30 days for payment). Each member electing to use this service will be assigned a unique number and will be asked to sign their chit(s) before departing.

- 22. A report from our Greenskeeper is attached, as is a reminder of our membership, green fee, and cart rental charge rates.
- 23. The next meeting of the Board of Directors will be on Tuesday 24 May 2016 at 19:00 hours (7 PM) at the clubhouse.
- 24. The meeting adjourned at 19:05 hours (7:05 PM).

Greenskeeper's Report

We have uncovered all greens, tees and everything has overwintered well. The fairways also overwintered well. The unusual cold weather we are experiencing this week will cause things to go off colour a bit but it should only burn the tips of the grass. Some greens grew a bit last fall under the tarps but that only added an extra bit of protection this spring. The course is still very wet from all the rain last week so we will be staying off it as much as possible.

We have removed the weather station from the field we sold and will be repositioning it next week.

Aaron goose management has been out once to scout out our goose problem. They will be back either later this week or early next week.

All new golf carts have had there spring check up, oil change and cleaned air filters. We are still waiting on parts for a few of our maintenance equipment and maintenance carts.

We picked up a lot of branches from the ice wind storm in the winter. There is still a lot of raking to be done and a lot of course set up. So far we have eight or nine member volunteers and I will let them know when they are needed which is probably when the weather gets better. Due to the weather and not being able to get on the course I don't believe the course should be open until between the 21st to 27th of April.
