

## MGC COVID-19 Club Storage Protocol

Note that this Protocol is a dynamic document and will change as new information becomes available from the health authorities and we gain experience with our processes and procedures.

It is posted on the members section of the Club's website.

### Introduction

The Mississippi Golf Club has the obligation to maintain a safe and healthy environment for our members, guests and employees.

To ensure the safety of members and staff at the Mississippi during this COVID-19 pandemic and provide club storage, these procedures have been developed and implemented. **Club cleaning will not be provided.** 

## Compliance

Members are expected to comply with the procedures in this protocol. Failure to do so puts you and others at risk and will result in you losing club storage privileges.

#### Club Storage Process for Walkers

- The back-shop staff will place the bag on the bag stands prior to the start of a member's round
- If using a pull cart or an electric caddy, it is the member's responsibility to place their bag on it.
- Bags are to be dropped in front of the bag storage room by the member following their round.

## **Club Storage Process for Cart Riders**

- Bags will be placed on carts by the back-shop staff prior to the start of a member's round.
- Members are to leave their bags on their cart at the end of their round. Bags will be removed from carts by the back-shop staff.

#### Member Responsibilities

- Maintain physical distance of at least 2 meters from others when picking up and dropping off bags.
- A mask must be worn when picking up your bag off of the bag stand. Sanitize your hands after handling.
- A mask must be worn when dropping off your bag in front of the bag storage room. Sanitize your hands after handling.
- DO NOT request club cleaning.

# **Back-shop Staff Responsibilities**

- A mask must be worn whenever handling a bag.
- Maintain physical distance of at least 2 meters from others when handling bags.
- Proper hand hygiene is an important control measure. Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Times to clean hands on the job include:
  - Before and after handling bags
  - Before and after work shifts
  - Before and after work breaks
  - After touching frequently touched surfaces
  - After putting on, touching, or removing a face mask
- Other times to clean hands include:
  - Before eating food
  - After using the toilet
  - o After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
