Challenges start
May 10th

- ❑ **Chip-ins** – sink it from anywhere off the green (using any club), record the hole number and date, get it attested, and drop your slip in the box in the Ladies' Lounge. Leaderboard posted each month.
- ❑ **Birdies** – for each birdie, record the hole number and date, get it attested, and drop your slip in the box in the Ladies' Lounge. Leaderboard posted each month.
- ❑ **Ringers** – record first full game in the Ladies Lounge, then record each time you better a score for any hole, creating an “ultimate scorecard” by the end of the season.
- ❑ **Low Net** – record your first game handicap, tee, gross and net scores in the Ladies Lounge. Record lower net info when achieved.
